

Household Hazardous Waste

Many items in your home are considered hazardous. Please dispose of the following items properly:

- Paint (Latex, oil based, varnishes and stains)
- Household Cleansers
- Automotive Products (Motor oil and antifreeze)
- Car Batteries
- Garden Products (Fertilizers, pesticides, and chemicals)
- Art & Hobby Supplies
- Furniture & Metal Polishes
- Household Batteries (Alkaline, Ni-Cd, and Lithium)
- Fluorescent Lamps (Including compact fluorescent light bulbs)
- Photo-Chemicals
- Aerosol Cans
- Pharmaceutical/Prescription Drugs

These substances should be taken to one of the following drop off locations listed below or taken to a San Mateo County Household Hazardous Waste Event. An appointment is required to attend an event. Please call 363-4718 or schedule an appointment online at <http://events.smhealth.org/events/>
