



NOTICE OF CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Linfield/Middlefield/Willow Traffic Study

WHAT: The City Council will be reviewing a traffic study prepared for the Linfield/Middlefield/Willow area for the following three development proposals:

- **321 Middlefield Road** – Conversion of an existing building of 48,400 square feet from general office to medical office
- **75 Willow Road** – 33 new residential units replacing an office building of 39,000 square feet
- **8 Homewood Place** – A maximum of 37 new residential units replacing an office building of 21,139 square feet

In addition, the traffic study accounts for the impacts of the following two development proposals for which a separate traffic study and Environmental Impact Report (EIR) has already been prepared:

- **110 Linfield Drive** – 22 new residential units replacing an office building of 17,500 square feet
- **175 Linfield Drive** – 34 new residential units replacing an office building of 38,000 square feet

WHERE: **Council Chambers, 701 Laurel Street, Menlo Park**
