



## **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Menlo Park, California, will hold a Public Hearing to consider increasing the maximum allowable rates for customers within the City of Menlo Park for the collection, processing, and disposal of landfilled waste, recyclable, and compostable materials. In addition, the City Council hereby gives public notice of its intent to increase the existing fees for supplemental services not covered in the monthly base rates, such as backyard service distance charges. See specific rate information at [menlopark.org/garbage](http://menlopark.org/garbage). If approved, these rate increases will be effective on January 1 of each listed year for 2018, 2019 and 2020.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Menlo Park will hold this Public Hearing, November 14, 2017 at 7:00 p.m., or as near as possible thereafter, in the City Council Chambers of the City of Menlo Park located at 701 Laurel St., Menlo Park, California, at which time and place interested persons may appear and be heard on the matter. Any interested person may present verbal or written input to the City Council on the proposed maximums. If written protests are presented by a majority of property owners (and/or solid waste customers) prior to the close of the public hearing, the City Council will not increase the rates as a matter of law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that if you challenge this matter in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Menlo Park at, or before, the Public Hearing.
