Major Traffic Changes Hwy101/Willow Road Interchange in Menlo Park

Traffic Routed to Temporary Connector Ramps

Menlo Park – Caltrans will reconfigure the Highway 101/Willow Road Interchange during the late night/early morning hours of Tuesday-Wednesday, November 7-8, 2017, closing many of the diagonal on/off ramps and replacing them with loop on/off ramps. The new alignments will be temporary - in place for six months - part of a larger project to rebuild the busy interchange.

Working hours will begin after 10:00 pm on Tuesday and Wednesday night and end before the morning commute. While the configuration of the on/off ramps will be changed, all connections between Hwy 101 and Willow Road will be available during construction and afterward.

Construction signs will guide motorists through the new on/off ramp. However, Caltrans urges motorists to be alert and allow extra time, especially in the first few weeks of the new configuration, as the new ramps will have tighter turning radiuses. Also, many of the connections that were once free-flow will now be signalized.

The re-routing of traffic will create space for work crews to build the next phase of the interchange. The project will be completed by the end of next year.
