October 30, 2017	1st hearing: gather public input on the composition of zones	Completed
November 29, 2017	2nd hearing: gather public input on the composition of zones	Completed
December 12, 2017	City Council adopts guidelines and approves application form for an up to 9-member Advisory Districting Committee and Committee recruitment opens	Completed
January 8, 2018	Deadline to receive Advisory Districting Committee applications	
January 16, 2018	Three committee members selected by random draw; these three appoint the remaining six committee members	
January 16, 2018	City Council direction on Charter Committee	
January 20, 2018	Advisory Districting Committee appointments completed	
January 25, 2018	First meeting of Advisory Districting Committee: provide Brown Act, districting criteria and interactive map training; schedule public meetings; discuss public outreach	
January 25-February 22	Advisory Districting Committee meetings; anticipate 5-6 meetings on weekly basis	
Early 2018	City Council considers enabling ordinance creating an Independent Redistricting Commission for 2020 census	
March 13, 2018	City Council considers Advisory Districting Committee recommended map	
March 26, 2018	If City Council rejects first map, Advisory Districting Committee submits second map(s) and proposed sequencing to City Clerk for publishing – must be published at least 7 days before 3rd hearing	
April 2, 3 or 4, 2018	3rd hearing: public input on draft maps and election sequencing	
April 17, 2018	4th hearing: public input on draft maps and election sequencing; Possible map selection and ordinance introduction	
April 24, 2018	Second Reading and final adoption of ordinance	
May 2018	Map submitted to San Mateo County Registrar of Voters	
November 2018	First by-district election in three districts (and possibly Mayor)	
November 2020	First by-district elections in remaining districts	
2021	Districts redrawn to reflect 2020 census data utilizing Independent Redistricting Commission
